17 Days: Bombay-Hyderabad-Bangalore-Mysore-Madras-Madurai-Cochin-Goa-Bombay

Golden beaches, riotously decorated temples, and lush tropical scenery are just some of attractions of the lesser-explored paradise that is the south of India. The tour will take you from the cosmopolitan city of Bombay to the bastion of East India Company at Madras, to the unending backwaters of Kerala, and finally on to Goa, the Rome of the East and one of Asia's finest beach resort.

- Day 12 Drive Madurai/Quilon and then drive along the backwaters of Kerala coast to arrive at Cochin
- Day 13 Cochin: Morning city tour, afternoon boat ride
- Day 14 Fly Cochin/Goa
- Day 15 Goa: Morning city tour, rest of the day free at leisure
- Day 16 Morning at leisure, afternoon fly Goa/Bombay
- Day 17 Depart Bombay

Srilanka - Emerald island set in the Indian Ocean, Sri Lanka was the legendary kingdom of the demon king Ravana who in the epic Ramayana battled with Lord Rama. Colombo is the capital, at bay with the sea, drawing cool breezes all year long. You'll drive through the streets with grand buildings, You'll marvel at Buddhist and Hindu temples and their relics and remnants of the museum. You'll see how trees grow old and graceful in Asia's first zoological gardens. Then at the Mt Lavinia beach, you'll return to this century, shopping knick-knacks at the local bazar called pettah.

Kingdoms of the Himalayas

20 Days: Delhi-Darjeeling-Bhutan-Sikkim-Culcutta-Kathmandu-Delhi

The Himalayas are said to be the abode of Gods. Here you discover the hidden kingdoms of Nepal, Bhutan, and Sikkim. Their cultures meet and fuse; each kingdom influencing the other while retaining its own identity.

Our journey begins at Darjeeling - nestling at the base of the Himalayas. From here you enter Bhutan, 'the land of the dragon', cautiously opening its doors to a privileged few. Then on to Sikkim, the Lama country, a curious blend of mythology, mysticism, and magic. And finally to Nepal where great related and differing perspectives merge.

Tibet - We present here a short itinerary that starts with the world's most scenic flight over the mighty Himalaya from Kathmandu to Lhasa. All this culminates on an arid plateau treasure trove of Buddhist Monasteries - the Drepung, once the largest: the Jokhang - a spiritual center, and the awesome palaces of Norbulingka or the Potala Palace envelope us. Ancient Barkhor Bazar still barters the bric-brac in this region that's not so much a little strange as utterly surreal.
